Thus during 2018 MFCD have carried out training programs in this regard among community based organizations. These training programs enhanced the understanding of volunteers who are field workers and represent more than Thirty Five community based organizations. This area covers not only humanitarian services rendered by Non Governmental Organizations (NGOs) but also services provided by various state sectors. Through out the period *four programs have been done and 250 volunteers were trained. In the 2019 plan, PSEA has been integrated.*
