PLATFORM FOR ACTION, COMMITMENTS AND TRANSFORMATION

During the first-ever World Humanitarian Summit, held from 23 to 24 May 2016 in Istanbul, world leaders came together with a common purpose: to reaffirm their commitment to humanity and chart a course to address the suffering of the 130 million people affected by humanitarian crisis and the millions more living in constant risk and vulnerability.

At the Summit, UN Member States, NGOs, private sector companies, UN entities and a diverse range of other stakeholders announced **thousands of commitments** to turn UN Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon's Agenda for Humanity and its five core responsibilities into reality.

To sustain the spirit of shared responsibility and the collaboration demonstrated at the Summit and to ensure continued progress in the advancement of the Agenda for Humanity, the online **Platform for Action, Commitments and Transformation (PACT)** has been created.

PACT will serve as a dynamic advocacy and implementation tool for all stakeholders in their efforts to advance the Agenda for Humanity and the commitments made at the Summit and to foster new commitments and partnerships.
