We have held several events within the confines of our goal:

1. Celebration of International Youth Day

On 12 August 2017 under the theme "Youth are the followers of the Leader of Nation", the Y-PEER youth-led network (NGO "Hamsol ba Hamsol") in collaboration with Committee on Youth and Sport under the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan, UNFPA Tajikistan, as well as other national NGOs and business representatives conducted "Volunteerism as a career ladder".

The Project aims to empower the youth of Varzob District through strengthening the legal and material status of the NCs.

Project objectives are focused on the following items: to improve the effectiveness of village structures; to enable the NCs to address the communities' needs including youth and women; and to initiate efforts to support the development of democratic leadership, increased participation and accountability, the acquisition of resources and their transparent management, and project planning and development.

The Compact for Young People in Humanitarian Action :

What concrete actions have you taken in support of the initiative.

Within the framework of the project "Supporting the reform of the civil registration system in the Republic of Tajikistan" implemented jointly with the NGO ANTI since August 27, ToT on the theatre based performances plus theatre-methodology of conveying messages were conducted for the activists of the Rudaki district. The ToT entirely has been conducted based on the "peer to peer" approach and defined standards. The key goal of the theatre-based performances is considered to increase the level of awareness of the population about the problems of civil registration, the importance of timely registration of acts of civil status and obtaining a birth certificate of the child. The project was implemented by Y-PEER Tajikistan. Local implementation partners are the local executive body of the state power and the youth and sports sectors of the Rudaki district.
